For Saturday evening, May 25 through Sunday, May 26:

33. הַיּוֹם שְׁלשָׁה וּשְׁלשִׁים יוֹם שֶׁהֵם אַרְבָּעָה שָׁבוּעוֹת. וְחֵמִשָּׁה יָמִים לַעֹמֵר

Hayom shloshah u-shloshim yom, sh'hem arba'ah shavuot v'chamishah yamim la'omer.
