1. Each evening, recite the blessing:

*Baruch atah adonay eloheynu melech ha'olam asher kidshanu bemitzvotav  
vetzivanu al sefirat ha'omer*

Blessed are you, ETERNAL, our God, the sovereign of all, who has made us holy with your mitzvot and commanded us concerning the counting of the Omer.

	<p>For Sunday evening, April 28 through Monday, April 29:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">6. הַיּוֹם שֵׁשָׁה יָמִים לְעֹמֶר</p> <p><i>Hayom shishah yamim la'omer.</i> Today is the sixth day of the Omer. (Seventh day of Passover starts tonight.)</p>
	<p>For Monday evening, April 29 through Tuesday, April 30:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">7. הַיּוֹם שִׁבְעָה יָמִים שָׁהֵם שְׁבוּעַת אֶחָד לְעֹמֶר</p> <p><i>Hayom shivah yamim, sh'hem shavua echad la'omer.</i> Today is the seventh day, making one week of the Omer. (Eighth day of Passover starts tonight.)</p>
	<p>For Tuesday evening, April 30 through Wednesday, May 1:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">8. הַיּוֹם שְׁמוֹנָה יָמִים שָׁהֵם שְׁבוּעַת אֶחָד וַיּוֹם אֶחָד לְעֹמֶר</p> <p><i>Hayom shmonah yamim, sh'hem shavua echad v'yom echad la'omer.</i> Today is the eighth day, making one week and one day of the Omer.</p>
	<p>For Wednesday evening, May 1 through Thursday, May 2:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">9. הַיּוֹם תִּשְׁעָה יָמִים שָׁהֵם שְׁבוּעַת אֶחָד וּשְׁנֵי יָמִים לְעֹמֶר</p> <p><i>Hayom tishah yamim, sh'hem shavua echad ushnei yamim la'omer.</i> Today is the ninth day, making one week and two days of the Omer.</p>

# Counting the Homer for Thursday evening, May 2 through Saturday evening, May 4




## 1. Each evening, recite the blessing:

	For Thursday evening, May 2 through Friday, May 3: 10. הַיּוֹם עֶשְׂרֵה יָמִים שָׁהִם שְׁבוּעַ אֶחָד וּשְׁלֹשָׁה יָמִים לְעֹמֶר <i>Hayom asarah yamim, sh'hem shavua echad u'sheloshah yamim la'omer.</i> Today is the tenth day, making one week and three days of the Omer.
	For Friday evening, May 3 through Saturday, May 4: 11. הַיּוֹם אֶחָד-עָשָׂר יוֹם שָׁהִם שְׁבוּעַ אֶחָד וְאַרְבָּעָה יָמִים לְעֹמֶר <i>Hayom achad-asar yom, sh'hem shavua echad v'arba'ah yamim la'omer.</i> Today is the eleventh day, making one week and four days of the Omer.
	For Saturday evening, May 4 through Sunday, May 5: 12. הַיּוֹם שְׁנַיִם-עָשָׂר יוֹם שָׁהִם שְׁבוּעַ אֶחָד וְחָמֵשָׁה יָמִים לְעֹמֶר <i>Hayom sh'nem-asar yom, sh'hem shavua echad v'chamishah yamim la'omer.</i> Today is the twelfth day, making one week and five days of the Omer.
