	For Saturday evening, May 6 through Sunday, May 7: הַיּוֹם שֵׁשָׁה וְעֶשְׂרִים יוֹם שָׁהֵם שְׁלֹשָׁה שָׁבוּעוֹת וְחֲמִשָּׁה יָמִים לָעֹמֶר <i>Hayom shishah v'esrim yom, sh'hem shloshah shavuot v'chamishah yamim la'omer.</i> Today is the twenty-sixth day, making three weeks and five days of the Omer.
