

# Counting the Homer for Sunday evening, May 28 through Monday evening, May 29

## 1. Each evening, recite the blessing:

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה' אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשָׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתָיו וְצִוָּנוּ עַל סִפְרַת הָעֹמֶר

*Baruch atah adonay eloheynu melech ha'olam asher kidshanu bemitzvotav  
vetzivanu al sefirat ha'omer*

Blessed are you, ETERNAL, our God, the sovereign of all, who has made us holy with your mitzvot and commanded us concerning the counting of the Omer.

## 2. Count the Homer for each day:



For Sunday evening, May 28 through Monday, May 29:

48. הַיּוֹם שְׁמוֹנֶה וָאַרְבָּעִים יוֹם שָׁהִם שְׁשָׁה שָׁבוּעוֹת וְשֵׁשׁ יָמִים לְעֹמֶר

*Hayom shemonah v'arba'im yom, sh'hem shishah shavuot  
v'shishah yamim la'omer.*

Today is the forty-eighth day, making six weeks and six days of the Omer.



For Monday evening, May 29 through Tuesday, May 30:

49. הַיּוֹם תִּשְׁעָה וָאַרְבָּעִים יוֹם שָׁהִם שִׁבְעָה שָׁבוּעוֹת לְעֹמֶר

*Hayom tishah v'arba'im yom, sh'hem shivah shavuot la'omer.*

Today is the forty-ninth day, making seven weeks of the Omer.
